Eligibility:

- To be eligible for the scholarship an applicant must be a graduating high school student in the Cape Fear Tri-County area (New Hanover, Brunswick and Pender counties) during the 2013-2014 school year.
- The applicant must continue their study of vocal performing arts or music education in a post-secondary institution.
- The applicant must be an active member of a vocal performing arts program during the 2013-2014 school year.

Application:

- On a CD the applicant must provide a complete song or movement of at least two minutes in length which showcases their range and ability.
- Application form and audition CD must be post-marked by January 15, 2014.
- Please note that each applicant must provide a **PERSONAL RESPONSE STATEMENT** to be completed on a separate sheet of paper.

Rules & Requirements:

- If any applicant is a student of a participating judge, that judge will declare that relationship.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- If necessary, live auditions will be conducted.
- Recipients are expected to apply the scholarship toward academic expenses and it will be paid directly to the college or university.
- The recipient may be asked to perform as a guest soloist at the WCS Spring concert on May 18, 2014.
